1. General

Several of the Department's comments are similar in nature to those submitted by the EPA on July 13, 2006. In order to minimize redundancy, the Department concurs with those comments submitted by the EPA in addition to the following comments:

2. SWMU 32

The Department does not recall the investigation of SWMU 32 in conjunction with the SWMU 45 RI/RFI and RI/RFI Addendum. Please verify that SWMU 32 will be addressed concurrently with SWMU 45.

3. SWMU 45

It is stated that there are no primary deliverable for FY 07 regarding SWMU 45; however, the Milestone Schedule indicates that a FS is to be submitted on July 2, 2007. Please revise the text to be consistent.

4. Document Milestone Schedule

The EPA requested that this attachment be removed from the SMP; however, the EPA also suggests that the team continue to review this document during the team meetings. The Department does not object to this request. However, since this schedule was included in the draft SMP submittal, the Department offers the following comments:

a. General

The Department agrees with the EPA that the regulatory review timeframe for Draft Primary Documents should be 45 days to minimize the need for written extension requests.

b. General – ROD

Depending on the complexity of the ROD, the Department may need more than 20 days to issue a concurrence letter. Variables exist that may alter the time needed to secure the appropriate signature for the concurrence letter. The Department recommends allowing a minimum of 30 days to issue a concurrence letter for all RODs.

c. Site 3 Proposed Plan

The schedule indicates that the public comment period and a public meeting will occur prior to obtaining team concurrence. The Department recommends obtaining team concurrence prior to the initiation of public participation activities.

- d. Site 12 ROD  
The schedule for the Site 12 ROD appears to be outdated, please update.
- e. Site 13 and 14 PPs  
The public meeting is scheduled after the end of the public comment period. The public meeting must be held during the public comment period. Please revise accordingly.
- f. Site 27 PP  
The public meeting is scheduled after the end of the public comment period. The public meeting must be held during the public comment period. Please revise accordingly.
- g. Site 45 Treatability Studies  
Please ensure that the schedule for TS1 is consistent with the schedule provided by GeoSyntec.
- h. Site 45 PP  
The public meeting is scheduled after the end of the public comment period. The public meeting must be held during the public comment period. Please revise accordingly.
- i. Site 55 Fiber Optic Vault  
The SMP states that Site 55 will be addressed in conjunction with Sites 9/16/27; therefore, the Document Milestone Schedule for Site 55 should be the same as that for Sites 9/16/27. Please update accordingly.
