Hi folks,

I have been working with David on our comments for the Site 3 PP, and many questions started coming up with respect to what we really need to document in the PP/ROD, what documents we have finalized and/or drafted upon which we can base our Proposed Remedies, and how we move forward to accomplish what we need/want to do given what we have. That will make sense to Mark and Art, and maybe Meredith, because I have spoken to them. The rest of you may want to call me if you need clarification before the call. Bottom line is, David and I are working on a path forward proposal, which even though it is only a slightly different direction than where the Draft PP is, it will likely call for a fairly significant rewrite to the PP. Rather than issue extensive comments, we would prefer to:

1) Have a quick conference call to discuss the main issues and slightly new direction;

2) Make sure everyone (Art, MCRD, SCDHEC, Mark) is on board and understands what we are saying and why;

3) Identify what needs to happen and the different approaches the Navy/MCRD may take to get there.

4) Then we would only need to issue General Comments (avoiding the detailed voluminous specific comments which would otherwise be required) which document what we all agree to on the call.

5) Our comments would then call for the Navy/MCRD to revise the Draft PP (not yet a Draft Final, because we will not be there yet) to reflect the revised approach and details, and submit it for review and comment (or approval if we get really lucky.)

It looks like most, if not all of us are available for a call on THIS FRIDAY MORNING. I am proposing to start the call at 10:00 and hope that it will not take more than an hour. Before the call, I will issue an e-mail that contains an outline of what I have noted above, but with much more detail and explanation. Look for that e-mail. SO PLEASE REPLY TO THIS MESSAGE AND COPY EVERYONE - INDICATING IF YOU ARE AVAILABLE FOR THE CALL OR PROPOSING AN ALTERNATE TIME.
