Hi Meredith,

I am confused. Has DHEC decided not to participate in a team approach to scoping documents? The attached letter reads as if DHEC is not in agreement with the 500 meals, regardless of what explanation there may be, even though they also appear to not understand the explanations given to date. Yet, it appears that "a decision" will not be made until the document is submitted. If the state knows they are in disagreement with a parameter being used, then a discussion with the team should be called for by the state before the document is issued. Or if the state thinks they may be in disagreement but needs further explanation before they are sure, then they should ask for that explanation. However, the state appears to be insisting on a final draft document before attempting to reach consensus on the parameters. This is counter to the entire team approach. Please explain why the state is taking this approach and if this is going to be the state's procedures for all forthcoming documents, or just those with risk assessments, or what?
