I have not yet heard anyone speak to how we got from Site 14 being "Storm Sewer System" to being just "Outfalls". Were the pipes investigated under another program? if so, which, who is the contact, what were the findings (e.g, leaking, broken, replaced, closed, etc.)? THIS IS CRITICAL TO HAVING THE SITE 14 DISCUSSION AT THE UPCOMING MEETING.

It appears most of the other Sites on my list, except Site 14, are perhaps being handled under the UST program. I would like some basic information on each of these if possible.

- 1) A map showing all of their locations. (in general - does not have to be GIS) (or are these on our disk already?)
- 2) Current Status - e.g. pending, remediated, closed, etc.
- 3) If remediated or closed - By whom? and a link to their post remediation or closure sampling results. (e.g. a file, or website, or contact person's phone number, etc.; something simple and quick.)
