
Site 45 Site Visit on 4/27/2010

On April 27, 2010 Kent Krieg, Meredith Amick, Stacey French and myself from South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (DHEC) performed a site visit to Site 45 on Parris Island, Beaufort, SC. During the site visit, multiple permanent monitoring wells were found to be in need of maintenance. Per R-61-71, -H. of the South Carolina Well Standards, monitoring wells must be maintained. The wells observed were either damaged and/or the well identification plaques were either missing or illegible and could not be identified.
