The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Region 4 has reviewed the above subject decision document and has signed the Record of Decision (ROD) for Operable Unit 3, Site 3, Causeway Landfill. This remedy is supported by the previously completed Remedial Investigation, Feasibility Study, Baseline Risk Assessment, Proposed Plan, Interim ROD, Technical Memorandum Post-Interim Construction Risk Assessment, and Final Proposed Plan.

The selected remedy adopts the Interim Remedial Action as final with modification of Site 3 Land Use Controls (LUCs) to prohibit all fishing at the 3rd Battalion Pond and to require annotation and implementation of LUCs in the Marine Corps Recruit Depot (MCRD) Environmental Management System. The selected remedy also requires inspection and maintenance of the Site 3 landfill cover system. The ROD selects No Action for sediments and surface water. This remedial action is protective of human health and the environment, complies with Federal and State requirements that are legally applicable or relevant and appropriate to the remedial action and is cost effective.

Attached you will find a copy of the signature page from the ROD which now includes EPA's signature. Please replace the previous page with this signed version in your existing RODs. Please ensure the Final ROD is entered into the Site Administrative Record for MCRD, Parris Island, SC.

EPA appreciates the coordination efforts of MCRD and the Navy, as well as the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control, and recognizes the level of effort that

was put forth in the work leading to this decision. EPA looks forward to continuing the exemplary working relationship with MCRD Parris Island and Naval Facilities Engineering Command Southeast as we move toward a final cleanup of the NPL site. 
