RESPONSE TO COMMENTS

Draft-Final Remedial Investigation/Resource Conservation and Recovery Act Facility Investigation Uniform Federal Policy Sampling and Analysis Plan for Site 35, Defense Reutilization and Marketing Office Salvage Yard, Marine Corp Recruit Depot Parris Island, South Carolina, dated May 2014

General Response: Added "Final" to title on cover page

General Response: Revised date and version number for all replacement pages.

General Response: Telephone contact numbers for South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (SCDHEC) personnel were updated throughout the Uniform Federal Policy Sampling and Analysis Plan for Site 35 to account for a recent office re-location.

General Response: Language associated with Principal Study Questions (Worksheet 11-1) was revised to more closely match resulting Decision Rules.

General Response: Relevant figures were revised to depict historical soil sampling locations along the dry ditch according to the horizontal scale (one sample every approximately 150 linear feet) in the United States Environmental Protection Agency's *Surface Soil Sampling and Analysis Summary Report*, dated 2003. The distance between planned soil sampling locations along the dry ditch was adjusted to confirm results associated with the historical (2003) sampling event.

Responses to SCDHEC Comments, dated 27 June 2014

1. Figure 10-9: The Department believes that the zinc exceedances for all sample locations should be shown in Pink to indicate that they are both above Protection of Groundwater RSLs and ESVs.

Response: Figure 10-9 has been revised accordingly.

2. Table 10-3: A new color should be added to this table as well to indicate that Arsenic exceeds both Protection of Groundwater RSLs and Residential RSLs. Additionally the letter "a" should be added to the sample value for PAI03501, so that it reads "1.8ac".

Response: Table 10-3 has been revised to show that Arsenic exceeds both Protection of Groundwater and Residential RSLs. To account for this revision, minimal text in the executive summary and Section 10.5 has been modified accordingly.

3. Section 10.6.2: In order to clarify the administrative record for Site 13A, please clarify if the landfill is still permitted. If the landfill is not currently permitted, please provide closure documentation including any sampling results for the previously permitted landfill. Additionally, please clarify the landfill's current operation and regulatory status

Response: Marine Corp Recruit Depot Parris Island will respond separately to the concerns regarding Site 13A.
