Dear Mr. Parra and Ms. Donohoe:

The Division of Waste Management of the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (SCDHEC) completed the review of the above referenced document received April 8, 2016. The Department approves the document. Approval of this document constitutes a No Further Action Decision for UXO 1. Please note, the Department does not generally concur with an NFA decision for a munitions site. However, an NFA decision is warranted due to the evidence provided that a grenade range did not exist in the area designated as UXO 1.

In concurring with this No Further Action (NFA), the SCDHEC does not waive any right or authority it may have under federal or state law. SCDHEC reserves any right or authority it may have to require corrective action in accordance with the South Carolina Pollution Control Act and South Carolina Hazardous Waste Management Act. These rights include, but are not limited to, the right to insure that all clean-up goals and remedial criteria are met and to take separate action in the event clean-up goals and remedial criteria are not met. The SCDHEC may require additional response actions at the site should any of the following occur: (1) previously unknown or undetected conditions arise or are discovered at the site; (2) information provided to the SCDHEC concerning the site was invalid or inaccurate; (3) information concerning the site that may have affected the SCDHEC's decision to concur in the NFA was not provided; or (4) the final remedy is no longer protective of human health or the environment.
