Subj: PUBLIC INFORMATION WORKSHOP

Dear Mr. Roy:

A public informational workshop will be conducted on 25 January to present the most recent information on the corrective action permit relating to the technical review committee on which you serve. We would appreciate it if you could attend the workshop as well as the rehearsal, if possible.

The primary purpose of the workshop is to present and discuss the Navy's Media Protection Standards proposal. The objective of the MPS Proposal is to propose standards (based on human health and environmental risk assessments) for each medium (soil, groundwater, air, surface water and sediment) for chemical contaminants which may have been released from the Solid Waste Management Units (SWMUS) identified in the Portsmouth Naval Shipyard's HSWA permit.

At a later date when EPA and Maine DEP have preliminarily approved the Media Protection Standards presented by the Navy, EPA will offer a 45 day public comment period to provide the opportunity for observations to be made known. At the end of the 45 day comment period, EPA will also hold a public hearing in the Kittery area to provide the public a chance to ask questions directly. Based on comments received, the Media Protection Standards may then be revised if necessary.

The workshop will be held at the Kittery Lions Hall on State Road starting at 7pm, and the dry run/rehearsal will be held at 9:00am at the Kittery Town Hall Council Chambers on Rodgers Road. If you need any information, please contact me at (207) 438-3832/FAX 1535 or 3526.
