Based on detections of dioxins in the soil samples at Site 29, the Navy proposes to sample the seven monitoring wells at Site 29 using the low flow sampling protocol in the *Groundwater Monitoring Workplan*, December 1996. The groundwater samples will then be analyzed for dioxins. This sampling will be conducted in conjunction with the groundwater monitoring for radionuclides to be conducted in 1999.


A laboratory procedure for dioxin analysis in water will be forwarded under separate cover.
