The Navy announces a Record of Decision (ROD) for Operable Units 2 and 9, Rubble Disposal Area, Naval Air Station (NAS) South Weymouth, located in Weymouth, Massachusetts. The ROD, which was signed on December 31, 2003, documents the selected remedy for the site, which includes the removal and offsite disposal of PCB impacted material from the wetlands, the construction of a soil cap over the disposed material, long-term monitoring, and institutional controls.
