NOTICE OF ORDNANCE SURFACE CLEARANCE

Nomans Land Island Chilmark, MA

The U.S. Navy, in coordination with U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service and state/federal environmental regulatory agencies, will be conducting an ordnance surface clearance on Nomans Land Island over the summer. The objective of this clearance is to identify and remove and military ordnance that may have been exposed since the last effort was completed in 2003. Preliminary field activities began on 1 July and the clearance is expected to last into October. A comprehensive search of the island will be conducted and any items found will be made safe by detonating any remaining explosive charges. Explosions may be heard when demolition operations are being performed. Demolition operations, when necessary, are expected to occur only on Fridays.
