Dear Mr. Reisch:

This Office of the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) has reviewed the Draft Workplan and Sampling and Analysis Plan for the Site Screening Assessment (SSA) for the St. Juliens Creek Annex Site. We wish to make the following comments.

1. On Figure 2-1, Site Location Map, there are two locations labeled "Site 18." Please correct the map.
2. On page 3-3, in reference to Site10, it is stated that Alodine, a caustic detergent, was possibly disposed of at this location. It further states that one groundwater sample and two soil samples were collected and it provides a synopsis of constituents found. Since Alodine is caustic, if pH was not one of the parameters previously analyzed, I would recommend that this be added to the list of samples to be collected as part of the study and inserted into Table 4-1, Summary of Environmental Soil Samples.
3. Four typos were noted in the document. The first is on page 3-1, under IRP Sites. In the last sentence, "concentrations" is spelled "concentrations." The remaining three are found on page 4-11. In the second sentence following Table 4-2, "organics" and "inorganics" are misspelled. Finally, the last sentence of this section should state that

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“pH,” not “Eh” will be measured in the field.

We appreciate the opportunity to review and comment upon this and other documents.
