## **THE UNITED STATES ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY**

INVITES PUBLIC COMMENT ON THE  
FEDERAL FACILITY AGREEMENT FOR THE  
**USN St. Juliens Creek Annex**  
**Chesapeake, VIRGINIA**

The public comment period will last 45 days from  
from the date of publication of this notice.

The U. S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and the Commonwealth of Virginia have signed a Federal Facilities Agreement (FFA) with the United States Navy to continue the environmental cleanup program at the St. Juliens Creek Annex facility. The agreement outlines the three parties' roles in the investigation and cleanup of areas where contamination may exist. The Navy, as the lead agency, is responsible for conducting and paying for the study and the cleanup. EPA and the Commonwealth will oversee the project to ensure a thorough investigation and cleanup take place for the protection of the public health and environment. The agreement also provides the framework for the work to be done along with a discussion of the Site Management Plan which outlines schedules of all work required at the site.
