Team, here are the comments from tech support for the Site 5 pre-sampling plan. Comments are also from the tox as well.

EPA recommends sampling for the full suite of TAL metals total and dissolved. A full suite analysis will help in determining an increasing or decreasing trend in the shallow groundwater, as well as enhance the position that all metals (including cobalt) are not site related. Limiting the scope of the analysis will limit the assessment of the current groundwater conditions.

Also, please explain why anions and not cations are included in the proposal.
