Purpose

This Engineering Evaluation and Cost Analysis (EE/CA) report is being made available for public comment for a period of 30 days as mandated by the National Oil and Hazardous Substances Pollution Contingency Plan (NCP). The public comment period is from **May 14, 2002 until June 14, 2002.**

The EE/CA is for a non-time-critical removal action (NTCRA) of soil at Installation Restoration (IR) Site 3 (Landfill C) and IR Site 6 (Small Arms Pit), at the St. Juliens Creek Annex (SJCA), Chesapeake, Virginia. The St. Juliens Creek Annex Facility is situated at the confluence of St. Juliens Creek and the Elizabeth River in the city of Chesapeake, located in southeastern Virginia.

The purpose of the NTCRA is to reduce potential risks to human health and the environment by eliminating the identified potential risk at each of these sites.
