**NOTICE OF NAVY'S INVITATION
FOR PUBLIC COMMENT ON THE
Proposed Remedial Action Plan
Site 6 Small Arms Unit
St. Juliens Creek Annex**

The Department of the Navy (DoN) invites public comment on the Proposed Remedial Action Plan (PRAP) for Installation Restoration Site 6 Small Arms Unit, located on St. Juliens Creek Annex. The PRAP identifies and discusses the preferred alternative to address contaminated soil at Site 6.

In accordance with 40 CFR 300.430(f)(2), the assessment of risk information as related to both human health and the environment is detailed in the PRAP for Site 6. The PRAP includes a summary of the preferred remedial alternative for Site 6. The preferred alternative is No Further Action.

The PRAP is based upon the findings of previous site-related documents contained in the DoN's Administrative Record for St. Juliens Creek Annex. The Administrative Record can provide you with important background and site investigation information about Site 6. The Administrative Record and the PRAP are located for public review at the following location during normal business hours:
