



**INTERIM RECORD OF DECISION
FOR INSTALLATION
RESTORATION SITE 21,
INDUSTRIAL AREA
St. Juliens Creek Annex
Chesapeake, Virginia**

The Department of the Navy (DoN) Installation Restoration Program announces an Interim Record of Decision (ROD) for Site 21 at St. Juliens Creek Annex, Chesapeake, Virginia. The Interim ROD documents the interim remedial action chosen for the site and the basis for selecting the action. Verbal comments received during the public meeting held during the 45-day comment period are documented in the Responsiveness Summary which is provided as part of the Interim ROD. The Preferred Alternative is groundwater treatment through a two-phase approach: (1) in situ chemical reduction and (2) enhanced reductive dechlorination. The Navy and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency signed the ROD with written concurrence from the Virginia Department of Environmental Quality. Final signature on the ROD was received on May 12, 2010.
