**INTERIM REMEDIAL ACTION
SITE 21, INDUSTRIAL AREA
St. Juliens Creek Annex
Chesapeake, Virginia**

The Department of the Navy (DoN) Installation Restoration Program announces the initiation of the Interim Remedial Action for Site 21 at St. Juliens Creek Annex, Chesapeake, Virginia. The Interim Remedial Action will consist of groundwater treatment through a two-phase approach: (1) in situ chemical reduction and (2) enhanced reductive dechlorination. The Interim Remedial Action is being completed in accordance with the Basis of Design Report for Site 21, which was finalized in May 2010. The Interim Remedial Action was initiated on November 8, 2010, and is anticipated to be completed by September 30, 2011.
