Dear LCDR Smith:

The Department of Environmental Protection and Energy (NJDEPE) is in receipt of NAWCAD-Trenton's proposed ground water monitoring plan dated October 21, 1993. The monitoring plan was submitted to satisfy the requirements of seven underground storage tank removals with the above referenced Case Numbers in accordance with the NJDEPE's letters dated August 24, 27 and 31, 1993.

Upon review, the monitoring plan is Conditionally Approved, pending incorporation of the following comments to ensure consistency with the NJDEPE's "Technical Regulations", N.J.A.C 7:26-E et seq.

Comments

1. The monitoring plan specifies the screened intervals of each of the proposed monitoring wells. Be advised that all wells shall be screened across the water table. Therefore, the actual screened intervals may vary from those proposed based upon field conditions.
2. Base neutrals shall be analyzed by EPA Method 625, with a library search.
3. Volatile organics shall be analyzed using EPA Method 624, calibrated for xylenes, with a library search.
4. MW-36S (Tank E-4) shall be analyzed for volatile organics and methyl-tertiary-butyl-ether (MTBE) using EPA Method 624 calibrated for xylene and MTBE, with a library search.

Submittal of a revised monitoring plan is not required to comply with the requirements of this letter.



All other provisions of NJDEPE's August 24, 27, and 31 letters still apply with the exception of the Reporting Requirements in Section II, which is amended as follows.

A written report (RI Addendum Report) shall be submitted to the Bureau of Federal Case Management, within 90 days of receipt of this letter, specifying all activities conducted in compliance with the requirements listed in the August 24, 27 and 31 letters. To facilitate processing, please reference Case Number 92-06-09-1446 and UST Number 0060482 in the report. In addition, if ground water contamination is present, a Remedial Action Work Plan shall be submitted with the RI Addendum Report. If no further remediation is required for any or all of the removed USTs, a proposal for no further action shall be submitted.

Please note that the NJDEPE has consolidated the 7 separate Case Numbers into one Case Number. In all future correspondence, please make reference to Case Number 92-06-09-1446.




EXCAVATION NO. 2 FOR CRAIN






