On March 27, 1995, the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) received the Final Remedial Investigation Addendum Report for Underground Storage Tank Investigations for Case No. 92-06-09-1446 dated March 1995 prepared by the Naval Air Warfare Center, Aircraft Division, Trenton (NAWCADTRN). This report documents the remedial investigation and/or remedial action undertaken in response to the discharges from the above listed underground storage tanks.

The Report addressed six underground storage tanks. However, because additional remedial investigation and/or remedial action is required for three of the tanks, they were addressed under separate cover.

Based on our review of the information submitted, we find that NAWCADTRN has complied with NJDEP's existing requirements regarding remedial investigation and/or remedial action of Tanks E-4, E-8 and E-9 (#1). Therefore, no further action will be required at this time for the Tanks E-4, E-8 and E-9 (#1).

Please be advised that this approval only addresses the listed discharge(s) and tanks. This approval makes no representation regarding the environmental conditions of any other areas for the referenced property.
