Dear Mr. Polish:

The harmful physical effects of electromagnetic radiation on people is undisputed. Consequently, no U.S. Navy investigation of the environmental conditions at the Naval Air Warfare Center Aircraft Div. Trenton can be complete without a thorough investigation of the environmental electromagnetic radiation at this installation. The investigation must include both above surface and below surface powerlines and substations existing at this installation and in front of my house. The Navy has damaged high voltage power lines underground in front of my house and uses the overhead 13.2KV powerlines for the water pumping station on the Delaware River. Please note that the water lines from the pumping station to the Installation proper are routed behind my property on Sunset Ave. so that the combined geometry of the powerlines in front, and water lines and power lines behind my property form a giant Horseshoe Magnet around this residential zone which does not need high voltage powerlines. I have had a terrible powerline radiation problem at my residence since 1978 when P.S.F& G Co. increased the voltage of these powerlines on W. Upper Ferry Rd. from 5KV to 13.2KV.

I request your prompt investigation and resolution of this terrible environmental powerline radiation problem, now.
