Dear Ms. Felton:

The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) is in receipt of Revision 3 of the Work Plan for Underground Storage Tank Removal and Abandonment In-Place dated December 4, 1998. The document is acceptable provided that the following information is addressed at the time of closure.

NJDEP, hereby, approves the December 16, 1999 variance request by Foster Wheeler Environmental Corporation on behalf of the Navy, thus allowing for the collection of soil samples around instead of beneath bottom of the 550-gallon waste oil underground storage tank in the header pit that will be abandoned in-place. The samples should be as close to the centerline of the tank as possible.

In addition, as I discussed with a member of your staff on December 15, 1998, all soil samples collected will be analyzed as if they were for a waste oil tank pursuant to the New Jersey Technical Requirements for Site Remediation, specifically, N.J.A.C. 7:26 E-2.1(d), Table 2-1.

Finally, the remedial action report submitted at the conclusion of the removal and abandonment in-place shall be prepared in accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:26E-6.6.
