THIRD FIVE-YEAR REVIEW

Former Naval Air
 Warfare Center Trenton

The Department of the Navy, in cooperation
 with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agen-
 cy (EPA) and the New Jersey Department of
 Environmental Protection (NJDEP), has begun
 a five-year review of the remedies implement-
 ed at the former Naval Air Warfare Center
 (NAWC) Trenton, New Jersey. The purpose of
 the five-year review is to ensure that the se-
 lected remedies are effectively protecting
 public health and the environment. It is antici-
 pated that the Five-Year Review process will
 be completed in December 2013. This is the
 third Five-Year Review conducted for the for-
 mer NAWC Trenton.

The Five-Year Review is a comprehensive
 evaluation of the selected remedy for each
 site and may include:

- "interviewing local officials and community members
- "collecting information from local officials (zoning changes)
- "checking current site conditions and plans for site development
- "reviewing and assessing records and reports
