Home run derby draws a crowd in Doylestown

Doylestown Township Parks and Recreation and Doylestown Athletic Association teamed up to sponsor the annual Phillies Home Run Derby at Turk Park.

The free derby, for boys and girls ages 7 through 12, featured a visit from the Phillie Phanatic this year. The top three winners in each age group for both baseball and softball received a plaque, and the winners will be invited to participate in a regional final.

Braden Murphy, of Doylestown, collected 39 points to win the 11- and 12-year-old baseball competition. Andrew Whinney, of Furlong, and Brett Young, of New Hope, each scored 30

points to take the next two places.

For the 11- and 12-year-old girls, Taylor Molesky, of Doylestown, racked up 43 points to top her division. Cassie Smith, of Doylestown, took second place, and Brooke Soward, of Doylestown, came in third.

In the 9- and 10-year-old baseball group, Doylestown's Timmy Mahony led the way with 34 points. Liam Boyle, of Doylestown, came in second with 26 points. Harrison Yim, of Doylestown, and Tyler Dandrea, of Furlong, tied for third place with 25 points.

For the girls, it was an all-Doylestown top-three among the 9- and 10-year-olds. Ava Mattes won the division with 12 points,

followed by Jenna Molesky and Molly Gibson tied for second with nine points each. Madelyn Rute came in third.

Kellen O'Connor, of Furlong, set the pace for the 7- and 8-year-old boys with 30 points. Jack Hogenauer, of Doylestown, was second with 28 points, and Luke Borgmann took third with 26 points.

Mae Mahone, of Doylestown, won the softball contest for 7- and 8-year-olds with 13 points. Jillian Boyle, of Doylestown, came in second with 12 points, and Brynn Williamson finished third with 10 points.

The Naval Facilities Engineering Command Base Realignment and Closure Program Management Office (NAVFAC BRAC PMO) and the Air National Guard (ANG) are hosting open house public information sessions on **MAY 24th and 25th, 2016** at the Horsham Township Community Center regarding current and future actions taken in response to the perfluorinated compounds (PFCs) found in drinking water. Specific PFCs known as perfluorooctane sulfonate (PFOS) and perfluorooctanoic acid (PFOA) have been found at public and private drinking water wells near the Former Naval Air Station Joint Reserve Base (NASJRB) Willow Grove, former Naval Air Warfare Center (NAWC) Warminster, and Horsham Air Guard Station (HAGS), Pennsylvania. Attending these public information sessions will be representatives from the U.S. Navy, Air National Guard, U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Region 3, Agency for Toxic Substances and Disease Registry (ATSDR), Pennsylvania Dept. of Environmental Protection, Montgomery and Bucks County Health Departments, and local water authorities.

These sessions will be held in an **OPEN HOUSE** format with multiple information displays staffed by the various agency representatives, who will be available to talk one-on-one with residents and answer questions about PFOA and PFOS. Residents are encouraged to attend either session; the presented information will be the same at both sessions. Dates and times are shown below.

Information on other environmental restoration actions will also be available.
