Dear Mr. Monaco:

This letter regards the "Revised Subsurface Soil Investigation for Site 1" at NAWC.

In our letter of April 24, 1996, we requested that a series of confirmation (or exploratory) borings be conducted and the observations from these borings be considered prior to identifying the location of subsurface soil borings/samples for Trench TR8 and Pit P1. Our understanding is that the Navy has agreed to this approach.

Because these two former disposal areas are potential sources of high levels of TCE in groundwater underlying Area A, the locations of the subsurface soil boring/samples in this case should be carefully considered. As a result, we request an opportunity to review the logs for the confirmation (or exploratory) borings with the Navy and be provided an opportunity to comment on the proposed location of the sample borings before this work is performed.

Assuming the exploratory borings are conducted on April 30, this review and comment can be accomplished when the Technical Subcommittee of the RAB meets May 1. Should you have any questions or comments, please give me a call.
