## NOTICE OF ESTABLISHMENT OF NAVY RESTORATION ADVISORY BOARDS

The Navy will be forming Restoration Advisory Boards (RABs) in an effort to increase public participation in the Navy's environmental cleanup program.

### WHAT IS A RAB?

The RAB is a group which will be established for the purpose of allowing individuals opportunities to give advice to various Navy commands on their cleanup program. Members will also serve as the focal point for the exchange of information between the command and the local community. The intention of the RAB is to bring together community members who reflect the diverse interests within the local community, enabling the early and continued two-way flow of information, concerns and needs between the community and the installation.

### WHAT WILL BE EXPECTED OF ME?

RAB members will be asked to meet regularly to review and comment on technical documents and plans relating to the ongoing environmental studies and clean-ups at various Navy installations in the area. They will also be asked to attend all scheduled RAB meetings.

### HOW TO BECOME A RAB MEMBER?
