I need to update you on something that happened last week.

On Wednesday, 18 April 2007, approximately 2-3 tons of material from CAX Site 1 (Landfill Near Incinerator) was dumped for approximately 200 feet along State Route 14 on route to King and Queen County landfill when a tailgate broke open.
