Proposed Plan for Site 1 - Landfill Near Incinerator Naval Weapons Station Yorktown, Cheatham Annex

The Department of the Navy invites public comment on the Site 1 (Landfill Near Incinerator) Proposed Plan that presents information pertaining to proposed final clean-up alternative at Naval Weapons Station (WPNSTA) Yorktown, Cheatham Annex (CAX) located in Williamsburg, Virginia. Site 1 is approximately 2 acres comprising five former contaminant source areas: surface debris, main landfill (includes depression pool area), two small landfill lenses, and three wetland hot spots, located in the eastern portion of CAX. In accordance with the Code of Federal Regulation, 40 C.F.R. § 300.430(f)(2), the Proposed Plan presents assessments of risk to human health and the environment. The proposed final clean-up alternative outlined in the Proposed Plan is No Action. No Action was selected based on the completion of five removal actions that have eliminated all potential human health and ecological risks. Because there are no unacceptable risks, evaluation of action alternatives was not necessary.

The Proposed Plan is based on findings contained in documents that are part of the Administrative Record for CAX. The Administrative Record provides background information on Site 1, as well as remedial investigations conducted at the site.
