To All:

Attached is the response letter to address the final few remaining EPA comments on the CAX Site 7 UFP-SAP (final comments received from the EPA on 11/9/10).

As agreed to by the EPA on January 5, 2011 (via e-mail), the UFP-SAP would focus on collecting groundwater samples (and soil for pH) and defer sediment discussions to a later date. As a result of deferring the sediment discussions, all information regarding the soil risk screening results was to be removed from the UFP-SAP and included in the SI Report.

Since the risk screening information is being removed, I have attached a red-lined version of the Final UFP-SAP for you to take a look. Please note that this red-lined UFP-SAP is not as bad as it looks. The post-removal action data has been removed along with all the risk screening results. As a result, there were some changes to the environmental questions that need to be answered and the Project Quality Objectives (we had to add this information because initially it was not needed since the information was included with the results of the risk screenings). No changes to our scope of work were made, we just made changes to where the data is presented (UFP-SAP vs. SI Report).

Other changes you will see are as a result of changing the Dioxin lab. These changes were approved during the November Partnering Agenda Call on October 28th, however since you have not yet seen the changes, I included them in track changes.

Once we receive approval of this red-lined version of the UFP-SAP, we will accept the changes, re-format as necessary and send out a Final UFP-SAP hard copy to everyone. If anyone has any questions, please let me know.
