Dear Mr. Lewandowski:

The Record of Decision ("ROD") dated September 2006 for Site 1, the Privet Road Compound Soil, at the Naval Air Station Joint Reserve Base, Willow Grove ("Site 1"), has been reviewed by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania's Department of Environmental Protection (Department).

Site 1 soils were found to be contaminated with polychlorinated biphenyl compounds ("PCBs"), resulting from leaking of stored electrical transformers at Site 1. All soils containing PCBs in excess of 1 mg/kg were removed during June 1999, and disposed in approved facilities.

The Navy has selected a No Further Action remedy for Site 1, based on previous removal actions and post-removal confirmatory sampling.

The Department hereby concurs with the remedy selected for Site 1, the Privet Road Compound Soil for the following reasons and with the following conditions:

Pennsylvania's Land Recycling and Environmental Remediation Standards Act, Act 2 of 1995, 35 P.S. Sections 6026.101-6029.909 ("Act 2"), Pennsylvania's Solid Waste Management Act, Act 97 of 1980, as amended, 35 P.S. Section 6018.101 et seq. ("Act 97"), and the regulations adopted pursuant to these statutes are ARARs for this response. Implementation of any component or components of this response will not necessarily result in protection from liability pursuant to Act 2, for any party.

This concurrence with the selected remedial actions is not intended to provide any assurance pursuant to CERCLA Section 104(c)(3), 42 U.S.C. Section 9604(c)(3).



The Department reserves its rights and responsibilities to take independent enforcement actions pursuant to state and federal law.

This letter documents the Department's concurrence with the remedy selected by the Navy in the ROD for Site 1, the Privet Road Compound Soil. If you have any questions regarding this matter, please feel free to contact me at the above telephone number.
