Enclosed is the Navy's Final Remedial Decision Document to conduct free product recovery at the Navy's Fuel Farm, also known as IR Site 10, located at NASJRB Willow Grove, PA.

This final document has incorporated comments received from various RAB members during the comment period for the draft report which ended on June 13, 1997. A comment response document which includes the Navy's responses to those comments has also been included.

Construction of the full scale vacuum enhanced product recovery system to remove Light Non-Aqueous Phase Liquid (LNAPL) has already commenced. This technology was determined to be the most cost effective alternative due to the fact that most of the capital required for this system was already in place as part of the pilot study effort.
