1. GENERAL COMMENT - FIGURES

The addition of Figure 5-2 is extremely useful to EPA, and we appreciate its inclusion in the SMP. However, an additional figure listing the items described below would also be extremely beneficial to EPA:

-A figure which would compile, for all sites, a listing of the draft and final primary and secondary deliverable due dates, i.e. dates by which the Navy would forward deliverables to EPA and the Commonwealth. EPA is essentially looking for a figure that would contain a condensed schedule for the following deliverables:

- Removal Action Completion Reports
- SSA Work Plans
- SSA Project Reports
- RI/FS Work Plans
- Treatability Study Work Plans
- Treatability Study Reports
- RI/BRA/FS Reports
- Proposed Plans
- RODs
- Remedial Design documents
- Remedial Action Work Plans
- Remedial Action Completion Reports
- Long-Term Monitoring Work Plans
- Long-Term Monitoring Reports

-Operation and Maintenance Plans
