1. The Naval Energy and Environmental Support Activity (NEESA) is conducting, by contract, an Initial Assessment Study (IAS) at Naval Weapons Station Yorktown, as previously stated in reference (a). During reference (b), the command briefing was scheduled for 18 May 1983. John Accardi of NEESA will present a command briefing to the representative of Naval Weapons Station Yorktown on the purpose and objective of the Navy Assessment and Control of Installation Pollutants (NACIP) program and, in particular, on the IAS.
2. The command briefing will take about thirty minutes and will consist of a slide presentation, followed by a question and answer period. NEESA has selected an environmental consulting firm, C.C. Johnson and Associates of Silver Spring, Maryland, under Navy Contract N62474-83-C-6967, to conduct the IAS.
3. The on-site portion of the IAS has not been scheduled at this time. The command-designated point of contact, J. T. Lester, will be notified when arrangements are completed.
