Subj: DEBRIS REMOVAL FROM AREA B/C AT SITE 12

1. The purpose of this memo is to document an insignificant difference to the Site 12 Final Record of Decision.
2. Area B/C is located north of the main portion of the Site12 Landfill. The area is a ravine filled with miscellaneous construction debris and telephone poles. Sampling at Area B/C revealed the presence of low PAHs in soil but not at levels indicating significant risks. On March 3, 1998, regulatory, Navy, and consultant personnel conducted a Partnering teleconference. Teleconference participants included: Steve Mihalko – VADEQ, Rob Thomson and Bob Stroud – EPA Region III, Jeff Harlow and Scott Park – Navy, and Rich Hoff – Baker Environmental. As a prudent site management measure, all participants agreed removal of the debris at Area B/C would facilitate slope stabilization of the ravine adjacent to the landfill while also mitigating the need for potential long-term groundwater monitoring downgradient of Area B/C.
3. This memo serves as a record of consensus reached by the Partnering team.
