The latest RTC letter is attached, along with an updated figure as it pertains to Site 25. There are a couple of things that I wanted to point out and circle back with you on as a result of some discussions that we had at the end of our last partnering meeting.

RTC #1, as it applies to the chemical contents of building 386. These particular chemicals that were stored in that building were used as part of the operations that were performed in building 373. Most of the constituents don't have applicable screening criteria, but could potentially be reported as TICs. But, I believe that we agreed as a team that BTAG would have to provide some sort of site specific guidance as to how this data would be evaluated before the data would be provided.

RTC #5, 8, You posed a question to the BTAG folks during the partnering meeting conference call in reference to using a phased approach with regard to basing the need for any pore water, surface water and sediment sampling off of the evaluation of groundwater and soil sampling results. This approach has been used in the past at other sites and the Navy does not see why this site would be handled any differently. I believe that John was on board with this phased approach, but never got a definite approval from Peter.

Also, moving forward if after review of these RTCs, you find that you still have questions or comments, I would like to set up a conference call rather than facilitating another round of written comments and responses in order to expedite the process.
