Thank you for giving the DEQ the opportunity to review the Response to Comments Draft Phase I Remedial Investigation Report for Groundwater at Sites 1, 3, 6, 7, 11, 17, 24, and 25 (Draft Phase I RTC) dated January 8, 2007.

The September 2006 Draft Phase I was received by the DEQ on September 22, 2006. Mr. Eric Salopek, former DEQ RPM for the WPNSTA Yorktown site, submitted comments to Ms. Linda Cole, RPM for the Navy, on November 27, 2006. The Draft Phase I RTC was received by the DEQ on January 10, 2007.

The DEQ has reviewed the Draft Phase I RTC and acknowledges that all of the DEQ comments have been adequately addressed.

However, please note the following DEQ comments on the Draft Phase I RTC:

VDEQ Comment 1/Navy Response 1:

Please modify Section 7.5 of the final Phase I report to include the information that was provided by CH2MHill during the WPNSTA Yorktown/CAX Partnering Meeting on May 17, 2007. Specifically, please include a statement similar to, "Before proceeding with NFA recommendations for groundwater at Site 11, a groundwater sample will be collected at 11GW11 (just downgradient of the site) for analysis of [3,5-dinitroaniline,

nitroglycerine, and PETN]."

VDEQ Comment 4:

Please note that VDEQ Comment 4 should state, "VDEQ has concerns about elevated groundwater VC concentrations in areas within close proximity to habitable structures."
