Baker Environmental, Inc. (Baker) is pleased to submit one copy of the Draft Final Round ^{Two} ~~One~~ RI Report for the afore-mentioned Sites at Naval Weapons Station Yorktown, Yorktown, Virginia (WPNSTA Yorktown). Three copies of the RI Report have been sent to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) Region III; two copies have been sent to the Virginia Department of Environmental Quality (VDEQ); and three copies have been sent to WPNSTA Yorktown. One copy of the RI Report has been sent to Mr. Peter Knight, Mr. John McCloskey, Mr. Morris H. Roberts, Jr., and Mr. Jay N. Dewing; and one copy of the Executive Summary has been sent to ATSDR. The six remaining Restoration Advisory Board members and the eight remaining community members will receive a notice that the report is available in the Information Repositories.

The Draft RI Report was originally submitted in July 1998. At that time the Partnering team agreed to focus on higher priority sites and did not comment on the Draft RI Report. Therefore, this Draft Final version was submitted for your review. The exposure parameters and the toxicity data were updated for the human health risk assessment. Revisions to the ecological risk assessment included changing the aquatic receptors, from the bass and the bullfrog to the mink and the heron, and adding the bioaccumulative chemicals into receptor models.

Comments on the RI Report will be due on May 15, 2002. Baker is pleased to serve LANTDIV on this important project. Should you have any questions concerning this deliverable, please do not hesitate to contact me at (412) 269-2099.
