In addition, two new SOPs were developed as requested in the comments and are included here. These SOPs are:

- * F109 - Environmental On-Site Test Kit Sampling
- * F210 - Seepage Meter

As you are aware, these Draft Final documents are being submitted nearly one month behind the schedule set forth in the 1994/1995 Site Management Plan because of unresolved questions, which necessitated a second round of comments. As set forth in the Federal Facilities Agreement, you have 30 days in which to provide any additional comments. If none are received, these documents become final and will be issued as such. It is not anticipated that additional comments will be received, and therefore the field activities, originally scheduled to begin on July 5, 1994, will remain on schedule. If comments are received, the field activities may have to be delayed until the comments are addressed and resolved.
