Based upon the Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA's) April site inspection at the Yorktown Naval Weapons Station, Virginia, the following sites are being proposed for inclusion in an Expanded Site Investigations section of the upcoming three-party Federal Facility Agreement between the EPA, the Navy, and the Commonwealth of Virginia. These identified sites are in addition to the established 16 sites already under remedial investigation by the Navy:

The listing of Expanded Site Investigation areas to be included in the upcoming Federal Facility Agreement for the Yerktown Naval Weapons Station is being provided to the Navy as a courtesy, and to expedite the finalization of an approved Federal Facility Agreement. Please be aware that this list is not all-encompassing, as it was prepared based on existing knowledge of known disposal areas. In the future, other sites may come to the attention of the Navy, EPA, or the Commonwealth, that warrant the performance of a site investigation, and the Federal Facility Agreement should provide a mechanism for electing such areas for site investigations. In the meantime, this enclosed list will serve for the purpose of negotiating the Federal Facility Agreement.
