Dear Mr. Davidson:

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has reviewed the subject document dated September 8, 2000, and find it adequate for its intended purpose. EPA concurs with the selected action to remove approximately 1,390 cubic yards of soils contaminated with benzo(a)pyrene (BaP), Total recoverable petroleum hydrocarbons, arsenic, chromium, barium and antimony above Florida residential SCTLs. This action will prevent further migration of the contaminated soils into nearby drainage pathways and the groundwater. EPA recommends implementation as soon as possible.

This action will remove contaminated soils above the residential levels and will therefore not require any institutional controls for surface soils.
