The monthly meeting of the NAS Cecil Field RAB Steering Committee was held at 12 noon at the office of Keith Daw, LeBoeuf Lamb Law offices. **Review of December 19 Meeting**

- Evaluation forms were not used at the December 19 meeting. The practice of using and reviewing the evaluation forms will resume at the January 16, 1996 meeting.
- The Reuse Plan Update could be improved by superimposing the IR sites on the reuse map. This will help the RAB evaluate proposed remedial actions in terms of future use scenarios. The steering committee would like for Bob to reorganize his talk around reuse priorities.
- The talk on bioremediation was very informative. However, too much detail was provided, much of which the RAB had already heard. Also, Mr. Lunardini spoke softly and was sometimes difficult to hear.

**Upcoming Agendas**

The January training will be on *Toxicology for the Environment*. The presentation will be made by Marland Dulaney of ABB. The presentation will be made in two parts, with the second part given at the February meeting. (Postscript: Dr. Dulaney has requested that no homework assignment be made for the January meeting.
