Steering Committee Meeting Minutes **NAS Cecil Field Restoration Advisory Board** **Wednesday, April 17, 1996**

The monthly meeting of the NAS Cecil Field RAB Steering Committee was held at 12:00 noon at the office of Keith Daw, LeBoeuf Lamb Law offices. The following individuals were present: Keith Daw, Richard Darby, CDR Gardner, Tom Mackin, Diane Peterson, Nancy Rouse, and Lisa Routhier.

ADMINISTRATIVE:

Minutes of the March meeting were approved as amended.

REVIEW OF APRIL RAB MEETING

Review of evaluation form:

- With one exception, the new meeting location (the NAS Cecil Field Conference Center) received positive reviews from the members.
- One member requested a list of Operable Units (OU), including future reuse plans for each OU, be copied on the back of the agenda each month.

Open feedback from the Steering Committee:

- Keith Daw suggested that the discussion of the BEAR could have been broken down into two parts for ease of assimilation, noting that he did arrive in the middle of the presentation, which may have affected his perception of the difficulty of understanding the material. In the future, a copy of the executive summary of the report would be helpful.

MEETING AGENDAS

Projected agenda topics for the next three months include:

- **May:** The South Fuel Farm petroleum program.
- **June:** To prepare for the public meeting for Operable Unit 8 (anticipated to take place in June, 1996), a summary of remedial technologies (i.e., a review of technologies considered for cleanup at the South Fuel Farm) will be presented.
- **July:** Operable Unit 8.

Possible future agenda topics include:

- A dry run of the Outreach Committee's presentation (Rich Donoghue).
- The NEPA process (SouthDiv).
- SACM and how it applies to NAS Cecil Field environmental cleanup.
- Caretaker Status -- What happens after the base closes?
- The North Fuel Farm cleanup.
- Protections for prospective purchasers of contaminated properties (Keith Daw).

MISCELLANEOUS

Membership Status: Attendance seems to be leveling out with respect to meeting attendance. The current level of participation is considered adequate at this time.

Other Issues: NAS Cecil Field will have a new Commanding Officer before the next meeting. CDR Gardner will invite him to the May RAB meeting.
