

RAB Administration

November Meeting Minutes: November meeting minutes were accepted as written.

RAB Charter: The RAB voted to change the third bullet under the purpose statement in the charter to read "Facilitate and encourage public participation in the cleanup process at NAS Cecil Field."

Iran Maisonet Certificate of Appreciation: Iran Maisonet was presented with a certificate of appreciation for his perfect attendance for 17 consecutive RAB meetings.

New BRAC Officer: CDR Capponi was introduced as the new Base Transition Officer for NAS Cecil Field.

Base Update

CDR Gardner explained that NAS Cecil Field is experiencing some large budget cuts. This presents a problem because law requires that the condition of the base must be kept up until the base is turned over to the community for reuse.

Reuse Update

Mr. Bob Simpson informed the RAB of an upcoming meeting (December 19, 1996) with the Port Authority to discuss their reuse plans for the base. The next step is to get the Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) approved so that property can actually be transferred. The flightline continues to be a priority for reuse.

Sites Update

Steve Wilson provided his update via the *Sites Update* handout. He added that Southern Division Naval Facilities Engineering Command (SDIV) is also experiencing budget cuts, and they have been told to expect cuts in personnel.

RAB Year In Review

The RAB Year in Review and Long Range Planning was completed with a brainstorming session. The results of the brainstorming are summarized in the *1997 RAB Planning Worksheet*. RAB members will be asked to prioritize the activities identified in the brainstorming before the next meeting.

The RAB also discussed plans for the February joint RAB meeting with NAVSTA Mayport and NAS Jacksonville. Plans for the meeting are outlined in the December Steering Committee minutes.
