Dear Mr. Glass:

Based on the review of the Environmental Baseline Survey (EBS) for NAS Cecil Field dated November 1994, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) concurred on the identification of 270 uncontaminated parcels/buildings in June 1995. Since that time, the EPA has been working with the Navy on reviewing numerous parcels/buildings that had been placed under other BRAC categories.

EPA concurs with the review results that have identified the following "uncontaminated parcels" in accordance to CERCLA § 120 (h)(4)(A)(i-vii): 33, 140, 141, 174LS, 310LN, 323LS, 330, 340, 356, 360PS, 539, 618, 637, 701, 709, 826, 855, 884, 902, and 903.

However, based on the Remedial Investigations conducted at several sites under either CERCLA or the State of Florida Petroleum Program the following buildings should no longer be considered as uncontaminated due to the presence of contaminated groundwater:

830	Revised BRAC Category - 5/Yellow
831	Revised BRAC Category - 5/Yellow
561LN	Revised BRAC Category - 5/Yellow
1LN	Revised BRAC Category - 5/Yellow
286LS	Revised BRAC Category - 2/Blue
