Dear Mr. Kizer:

I have reviewed the Site Assessment Report (SAR) dated February 1999 (received February 4, 1999), submitted for this site. I found all the documents submitted to date to be adequate to meet the contamination assessment requirements of Rules 62-770.600 and 62-770.630, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.). FDEP concurs with the recommendation of the installation of two additional monitoring wells and a complete round of sampling prior to the development of a Remedial Action Plan (RAP). However, it is requested that EPA Method 8310 be used for PAH analysis, instead of Method 610. In addition, because of the presence of free product in three of the monitoring wells and seasonal fluctuations of the water table, a supplemental soil assessment may also be of value as part of this field effort.

A Remedial Action Plan should now be submitted according to the time-frame established by the BRAC Cleanup Team.


