Based on the review of the Environmental Baseline Survey (EBS) for NAS Cecil Field dated November 1994, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) concurred on the identification of 270 uncontaminated parcels/buildings in June 1995. Since that time, the EPA has been working with the Navy on reviewing numerous parcels/buildings that had been placed under other BRAC categories.

EPA concurs with the review results that have identified the following "uncontaminated parcels" in accordance to CERCLA § 120 (h)(4)(A)(i-vii) and no further action is warranted at this time: 1825, 498, 287, 290A, 430A, 305LN, 307LN, 309LN, 563LN, MB13, 808 and 952.
