The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has reviewed the subject document dated June 27, 2000, and find it acceptable for its intended purpose. EPA concurs with the selected action to remove approximately 173 cubic yards of soils contaminated with pesticides, inorganics and semivolatile; and recommends implementation as soon as possible.

The intended reuse for this area is light industrial. This action will remove contaminated soils above the residential levels. No further action should be necessary once the removal action is completed.
