Subject: Action Memorandum for Potential Source of Contamination (PSC) 21, Golf Course Maintenance Area (facilities 238, 370, 371, 397, 878). Naval Air Station Cecil Field, Jacksonville, Florida

Dear Mr. Davidson:

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has reviewed the subject document dated September 12, 2000, and find it adequate for its intended purpose. EPA concurs with the selected action to remove approximately 1,960 cubic yards of soils contaminated with arsenic, TRPH, total chlordane, 4,4'-DDT, toxaphene and dieldrin above Florida industrial SCTLs. This action will prevent further migration of the contaminated soils into nearby drainage pathways and the groundwater. EPA recommends implementation as soon as possible.

This action will remove contaminated soils above the industrial levels. However, because contamination will remain on site that exceeds residential risk levels, a land use control implementation plan (LUCIP) must be prepared. The LUCIP should be prepared and in place within 60-days of completion of the removal action.
