

## **Cecil Commerce Center and Cecil Field Airport Restoration Advisory Board (RAB) Steering Committee Meeting Minutes Tuesday, October 24, 2000**

### **Introduction**

The October meeting of the Cecil Field Steering Committee was held in the Conference Room of Building 82 at the Cecil Field Airport on October 24 at 6:30 PM. The meeting was a joint meeting of the Steering Committee and the Base Realignment and Closure (BRAC) Cleanup Team (BCT).

Meeting minutes from the July Steering Committee meeting were approved. It was decided that the field trip to the North Fuel Farm (NFF), scheduled for this evening, would be cancelled due to weather and darkness. The NFF presentation would involve a discussion of some recent pictures of the site.

### **Meeting Agendas**

The dates of the January and April meetings were tentatively set for the third Tuesdays of the month, January 16<sup>th</sup> and April 17<sup>th</sup>, respectively.

Based on a comment by Debbie Vaughn-Wright, it was decided that the Cecil Fielder and the RAB Agenda would be combined for future meetings. Comments about the July RAB minutes were then discussed. It was mentioned that Richard Donoghue's name should be removed from the list of RAB community members because he no longer lives in the area. Mark Davidson will contact Mr. Donoghue to see if he still wants to receive RAB mailings at his Tampa address. The status of David Farrell (USFWS) and Keith Halford (USGS) was also discussed. Scott Glass will contact USFWS and USGS to see if these agencies still want to participate in the RAB.

It was also mentioned that, when referring to A Avenue, the current name of the street (Aviation Avenue) be included.
